Camperland goes back to the 80s for its 25th Anniversary

Conneaut Lake, Pa. (June 1, 2011)—Camperland and Conneaut Lake Park will go back in time to celebrate 25 years of service to the Conneaut Lake and Meadville areas the weekend of Aug. 20-21.

The weekend will feature many family activities; including corn hole tournament, face painting, children's games, a scavenger hunt, a volleyball tournament, a picnic and more. Many events will carry an 80's theme with an 80's beauty pageant at 2 p.m. until 4:30 p.m., and an 80's dance from 7:30 p.m. until 10 p.m.

Conneaut Lake Park's Camperland was first built in 1986 where the former "Fairyland Forest" once existed. "Fairyland Forest," which used a combination of fairy tale characters and animals to help attract families and appeal to young children, had first opened in 1986 and closed in 1985 before Camperland was built. "Jonah the Whale" from "Fairyland Forest" can still be seen in the pond located within Camperland.

"I cannot believe it's been 25 years," Audrey King, a full-time employee said. "We would love for families to help us celebrate and we couldn't have done it without them."
